



**ADULT AMATEUR ATHLETIC WAIVER,
RELEASE OF LIABILITY & PLAYER CODE OF CONDUCT**
Please Read Before Signing

In consideration of being allowed to participate in any way in **MOC SPORTS, LLC** athletic sports programs, related events and activities, the undersigned acknowledges, appreciates, and agrees that:

- 1) The risk of injury from the activities involved in this program is significant, including the potential for permanent paralysis and death, and while particular rules, equipment, and personal discipline may reduce this risk, the risk of serious injury does exist; and,
- 2) I KNOWINGLY AND FREELY ASSUME ALL SUCH RISKS, both known and unknown, EVEN IF ARISING FROM THE NEGLIGENCE OF THE RELEASEES or others, and assume full responsibility for my participation; and
- 3) I willingly agree to comply with the stated and customary terms and conditions for participation. If, however, I observe any unusual significant hazard during my presence or participation, I will remove myself from participation and bring such to the attention of the nearest official immediately; and,
- 4) I, for myself and on behalf of my heirs, assigns, personal representatives and next of kin, HEREBY RELEASE AND HOLD HARMLESS MOC SPORTS, LLC, their officers, officials, agents, and/or employees, other participants, sponsoring agencies, sponsors, advertisers, and owners and lessors of premises and property used to conduct the event ("RELEASEES") with respect to any and all injury, disability, death, or loss or damage to person or property, whether arising from the negligence of the releases or otherwise.

PLAYER CODE OF CONDUCT

Philosophy

All sports programs offered by MOC Sports, including the Triangle Area Flag Football League Coed (TAFFL COED) are based on fun and participation. We understand a competitive environment is natural, however we expect team members and spectators to participate with this philosophy in mind. MOC Sports and TAFFL COED has a zero tolerance policy for captain, player, and spectator misconduct.

MOC Sports Mission

MOC Sports seeks to stimulate interest in athletics by providing adults and youth a competitively positive athletic environment, while emphasizing fun and helping develop positive social and networking skills.

The Code of Conduct for our Offerings

Players, captains, and spectators are expected to support league staff and officials, treat facilities with respect, and demonstrate good sportsmanship at all times.

Zero Tolerance Statement for All Sports

Verbal and physical abuse directed towards players, fans, and staff, as well as abuse of facilities will not be tolerated. Infractions are grounds for suspensions or expulsion from current and future MOC Sports program offerings. The zero tolerance policy applies to all players, captains, and spectators. PLEASE NOTE: Any team(s) or player(s) who is/are expelled from a MOC Sports' or TAFFL COED related event due to the failure to comply with this Player Code of Conduct is/are not subject to any full or partial refunds.

All Players are expected to adhere to the following guidelines:

- Good sportsmanship is expected and must be maintained at all times. Profanity or derogatory remarks will not be tolerated. All grievances must be communicated through the team Captain only
- All players and spectators are expected to follow the facility guidelines and be respectful of the facility at all times.
- The game officials have the authority to terminate prematurely any game they feel that the safety of the staff, players, and/or spectators has been compromised. The current score at the time of the termination will be the final score and shall determine the winner. In the event that a winning team is solely responsible for the termination, the winning team shall lose by forfeit. In the event that it is determined that both teams share responsibility in a terminated game, both teams shall receive a forfeit. Game officials' decisions are FINAL.
- In addition to the penalties and suspensions assessed under the League rules, League Authorities may, at their discretion, investigate any incident that occurs in connection with any game and may assess additional suspensions for any offense committed before, during, or after any game by a player or Team Official, whether or not such offense had been penalized by the Referee.
- Any player ejected from the game is required to leave the field/facility immediately. The player must leave the field/facility within ONE MINUTE after the ejection, before play is resumed or that player's team will forfeit the remainder of the game.

All participants are responsible for reviewing and understanding the rules and disciplinary actions as outlined in the rulebook. Rulebooks can be obtained from the TAFFL COED website (www.tafflcoed.com).

Game officials have full discretion in interpreting and applying the rules. Games officials' decisions are final.
